Changing Lanes can give you help with things like:

- Finding a training course/pre-apprenticeship/apprenticeship course that will suit you.
- Helping you with TAFE enrolments.
- Getting a job.
- Work experience.
- Preparing a résumé.
- Staying at school or getting into a school.
- Finding a place to live.
- Managing your finances.
- Getting your Driver's licence, Green card, RSA, and RCG.
- Life skills.
- Drug and alcohol information and counselling.
